Subject:-Grant of temporary affiliation for running 4 year B.Sc Nursing Programme from academic session 2020-21.

Sir,

Pursuant to the report of the Inspection Committee dated Feb. 06, 2020 and in anticipation of the approval of the competent body, the Vice Chancellor has authorized the:

Grant of temporary affiliation in favour of the Nursing College of Govt. Medical College, Baramulla for running 4 year B.Sc Nursing programme to the extent of 30 seats from the session 2020-21, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions, otherwise the University is vested with the authority to withdraw the affiliation forthwith under relevant sections of Kashmir and Jammu Universities Act, 1969 and concerned statutes :-

1. Seek recognition from the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi;
2. seek the recruitment of the fulltime Principal and the required teaching faculty as per the prescribed norms of the INC/ J&K Nursing Council/Affiliating University after following proper selection process;
3. seek the recruitment of non-teaching staff to make the office of the College functional as well as take care of the watch and ward of the campus;
4. ensure the upgradation of all the existing training labs as per the prescribed norms of regulatory/statutory bodies;
5. develop a library with at least 1000 books. or 100 books in different titles on each subject, whichever is more, of the proposed programmes to include both text books and reference books, besides two journals per subject, along with a book bank facility for students belonging to the Schedule Castes, Schedule Tribes/Minorities and such other sections as may be specified by the UGC from time to time;
6. seek the recruitment of professional Librarian to take care of all the library facilities;
7. provide all the basic facilities including recreation and sports, etc. to the students during the course of study;
8. provide accommodation to the male and female students in separate hostels with the required facilities;
9. appoint a Hostel warden and a PTI for looking after the management of hostel and sports related activities respectively;
10. develop the playground for the students for outdoor games and required facilities for indoor games;
11. have atleast two vehicles for purpose of shuttling students to and fro to community tours for training purpose;
12. procure and install LCD/Projectors in all class rooms/ lecture halls;
13. develop a computer lab with atleast 30 systems and 2 Printers;
14. connect the college with internet facility through broadband or leased line and install necessary medical software in all the computer systems and connect the college with other institutions to get benefit of E-medicine and latest medical and surgical techniques available in those institutes;
15. develop and create a website with all the necessary information as per the prescribed norms;
16. adhere to the rules and regulations governing the admission and examination of the programme as prescribed by the regulatory bodies viz INC/ State Nursing Council/affiliating University;
17. the admission/tuition fee chargeable from the students shall be same as notified by the Govt./affiliating University; and
18. pay the affiliation fee as prescribed by the affiliating University.
